

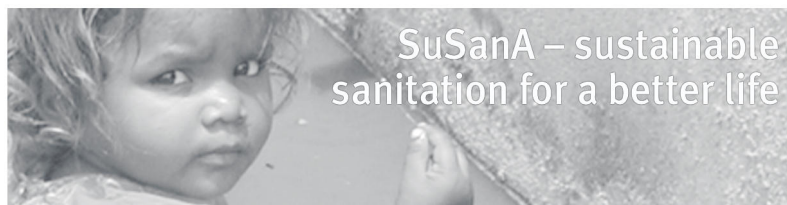

joint road map

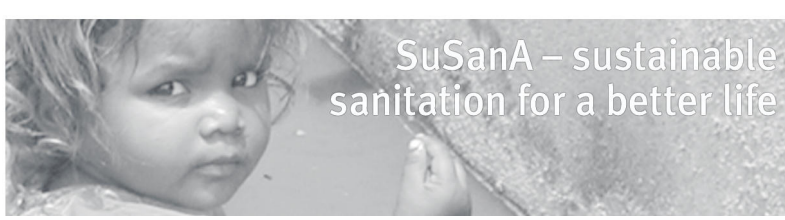
